Hi There,

Which version of protocols are you using? I think that might be a bug they fixed in a cs update.

Try highlighting a second or two before and after the audio starts and ends. I think this is the work around for that one. (also check out the digidesign users forum on ge digidesign site)

Also check that "Convert After Bounce" is checked in the bounce dialogue box.
